## MINUTES CCDHA ANNUAL MEETING SEPTEMBER 12, 2020

The annual meeting of the Country Club District Homes Association was held at 9:30 am on September 12, 2020 by Zoom video. In attendance were 18 member households, including Bev Elving, President of the Association, who presided.
