OFF DUTY POLICE DEPARTMENT NEIGHBORHOOD PATROL SERVICES

WESTWOOD ROAD SPEED BUMPS

The board suggests three speed bumps be installed on Westwood Road. In order for this to happen, seventy five percent of residents on both sides of Westwood Road need to sign a request document that may be down loaded from KCMO.org. NOTE: If there is an adjacent street whose only access is through the speed bump requesting street, that street also needs approval signatures of seventy five percent of residents on both sides of their street. Once the appropriate paperwork is submitted to the city and approved, the installment process proceeds.

A recommendation was made for the person that could contact Westwood Road residents for signatures. Aryn will approach that individual.

"MUSIC IN THE PARK" FUNDING REQUEST

The board agreed to donate two hundred and fifty dollars from WPHA funds to the West Plaza Neighborhood Homes Association to help defray band costs for the June 23 event being held in Westwood Park.

FENCES
