Coming Soon: Right Turn on Red!

Since the stoplight at State Line and Carnoustie was installed several years ago, Blue Hills residents have complained that we are not able to turn right on a red light to go north on State Line. Your neighborhood association board has been working with the City of KCMO to get this changed, and we are thrilled to announce that within the next couple of months, right turns on red will be allowed!

As you may recall, last year survey of Blue Hills residents showed that 54% said they would like to have a neighborhood social event. Within the next month or two, the stoplight will be modified so that the õNo right turn on redö sign will only be activated when the eastbound traffic on W. 128th Street from Leawood South is turn-



ing left onto State Line. At all other times, right turns on red from Carnoustie onto State Line will be allowed.
