How Well Networked Are You?

CCHA has set up an email network so that Block Captains can keep neighbors informed on timely issues such as crime alerts, upcoming CCHA and community events, lost pets, and other important and/or helpful information affecting our neighborhood. Neighborhood-wide emails are generated or reviewed by the CCHA Block Captain Coordinator, then sent to Block Captains for distribution to their neighbors.

The block email list is used solely for the distribution of CCHA emails to residents on your block, and is not shared with any outside party or individual. Emails are of particular interest to CCHA residents and are not used for promotion of specific products or services.

Want to be kept in the loop? Call your Block Captain (listed to the left on this page) and ask to be put on the block email list. Participating residents have found that it's a great way to stay informed and be better connected with their neighbors

If you do not have email access, but would



like to receive this timely information, please notify your Block Captain. They may be able to provide you the most important news another way, such as via a phone call or a printout of the email.

Have news to share with the neighborhood? Email it to your Block Captain with a request to distribute neighborhood-wide. Your Block Captain will submit it to the CCHA Block Captain Coordinator for review, approval, and distribution. Kansas City Redistricting will Likely Affect You

On December 8, the City Council voted in a new redistricting map for the city. This new map was approved without revision, and can be viewed at www.kcmo.org/idc/groups/cityplanningplanningdiv/documents/cityplanninganddevelopment/redistrictingIrevmapscenario.pdf

District 4 moves northward, stretching from Briarcliff to West 59th Street in the Brookside area. This now divides Country Club Homes in half, with those on the north side of West 59th Street remaining in District 4 and those on the south of W. 59th Street moving into District 6.

If you are in the 4th District, your city council members are Jan Marcason and Jim Glover (at large). If you are in the 6th District, your council members are John Sharp and Scott Taylor (at large).
