Snow Removal Assessment

Having prompt snow removal on days when we get more than a couple inches of snow is critically important to many in the Country Club Homes Association. While we are currently getting more frequent plowing from the City, we are not first on the list to have our streets cleared.

According to the City of Kansas City's website, there are more than 4,000 miles of residential streets in the city. Even with over 200 trucks clearing snow, it can take up to 12 hours to plow residential streets just once.

Country Club Homes Association employs an independent contractor to plow our streets on heavy snow days so that we can have access to and from our homes in a more timely fashion. The last time we had a Snow Removal Assessment was January of 2008. During the past 5-6 years we've had some light winters, but this past winter's excessive snow drained the last of the snow removal funds. There is a request to approve new funds on the ballot this year. Please make sure to vote during the Fall Rendezvous, and if you cannot make the event, fill out and mail in the ballot above.

Remember that during excessive snow events, vehicles should be moved into driveways or to the north side of the street so plows can get down narrow streets. If cars are parked along both sides, neither the City nor contractor will be able to plow your street. ~
