A BIT OF CRESTWOOD HISTORY

I recently received several file boxes of OLD Crestwood newsletters and some copies of original documents.

It turns out that on November 6, 1919 the plat for the south half of the Crestwood subdivision was recorded. Then on July 9, 1920 the plat was filed for the north half of the Crestwood subdivision

nally set up for 50 years. The in 1972 documents were amended to make it perpetual.

Originally the parks were created for the sole use of the homeowners who border them. It was not until 1946 that the I. C. Nichols company gave the Crestwood Homes Association ownership of the parks. At that time CHA became responsible for upkeep. The right of ways for others to access the parks and for maintenance access were legally negotiated in 1982.

In 1992 all the remaining responsibilities for enforcing building restrictions previously carried out by J. C. Nichols Co. were transferred to the Country Club Homes Association that then became the current Homes Association of Kansas City.

As time allows I am going to post some of these documents on the web site as a way to archive them.
