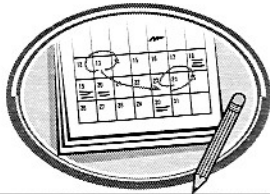
ANNUAL MEETING

City leaf and brush pick-up

This year there will be two weeks of pick-ups. Each house is allowed 20 leaf bags or bundles. Bundles cut 4 foot long and be 2 inches in diameter to be accepted. Bags may be placed at curb 3:00p.m. the day before pick-up.

PLEASE DO NOT PUT BAGS OUT AHEAD OF THAT TIME. Your neighbors don't like to look at them and it keeps the area looking its best.

Keeping leaves picked up keeps grass alive and neighborhoods looking tidy. Remember to keep leaves out of storm drains not in them.

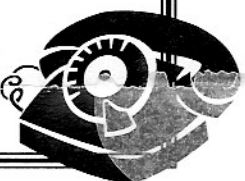
