Week of pick-up:

October 30th
November 6th
November 6th
November 13th
November 20th

Each house is allowed 20 leaf bags or bundles. Bundles must be cut 4 foot long and be 2 inches in diameter to be accepted.

Keeping leaves picked up keeps grass alive and neighborhoods looking tidy. Remember to keep leaves out of storm drains not in them.

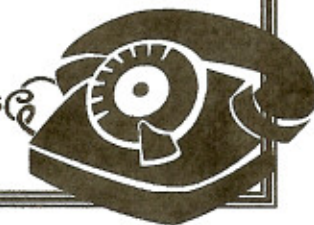
