As you know, many city services aimed at neighborhoods are slow to realization. Currently, the city HAS NOT announced a lot of changes in services, but we would like your opinion if they should....or if they are not currently adequate. Please indicate yes/no and add any comments.

Sidewalk repair: Many of our sidewalks are broken or uneven due to age and tree roots. Many homeowners contract companies to fix the sidewalks in front of their homes.
I would prefer to wait for the city to fix bad sidewalks on their timetable (if ever), and I understand I will be charged a special assessment fee by the city.
I would prefer the neighborhood association contract with a company to fix the sidewalks, in order of importance, and understand I will be charged a special assessment fee by the homes association if I choose to participate.
Bulky Item pickup: The city ceased collection of bulky items on a zone basis starting Sept. 1, 2008, and moved to a limited "by request only" basiswait time by zone has not yet been determined.
I'll call the city for my bulky item needsno matter how long it takes. I understand that my bulky items cannot be stored outside for more than 1 day waiting for pickup.
I would support the neighborhood association arranging bulky item drop off (not pickup) once or twice a year, even if there is a slight increase in dues to pay for the service. (Hazardous waste may be included)
Snow removal: Winter 2007/08 was particularly hard for the KC areaas a result, the neighborhood association spent much more money for snow/ice services than in past years.
I'm glad the association is providing more prompt/thorough service than the city, and understand that some years are harsher than others. The association should continue to provide this service on an as-needed basis.
The neighborhood should not pay for snow removal or ice treatment, no matter what. It's the city's responsibility.
