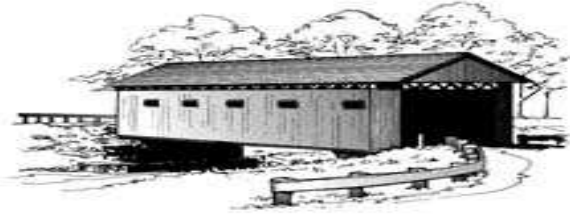

Don't be a victim! Protect your home with common sense:

- Don't leave valuables in your car, keep your car in the garage at night, and keep your garage and exterior doors locked.
- Be aware of who is in your neighborhood! If you see suspicious activity, **CALL 911**.
- Communicate with your neighbors. A vigilant block is a safer block.
- When you leave for vacation, leave some lights on and a radio playing. Put valuables in a safe deposit box.
- Tell your neighbors that you're leaving, when you'll be back, and give them your cell phone number. Tell neighbors on all sides of you, including the back.
