Highlights from the Annual Meeting:

Roughly 50 people attended the 2008 RBHA annual meeting on October 23, 2008 at the Red Bridge Theatres. George Gilchrist, owner of the shopping center, donated the meeting space; Lipari's SunFresh donated cider and cookies and Dunn's donated coffee. Thank you to all our donors!

Barbara Robertson, president/treasurer, reviewed the accomplishments and budget of the 2007/08 year. Accomplishments included increased communication via e-alerts and newsletters, more transparency and volunteer opportunities, our first holiday lighting contest, a new directory, new neighborhood stickers, a movie night and the first ever resident survey to assist successive boards in long-range planning. Snow removal and street treatment was a major expenditure in the past fiscal year; the pattern of dry winters may have finished it's cycle, necessitating more expenditure from the association, especially due to the city budget crisis. The final payment on refurbishing the entrance markers was also paid.

George Gilchrist, owner of the Red Bridge Shopping Center, took questions and comments from the audience about possible future tenants of the shopping center and how to increase traffic is this vital part of our neighborhood. Mr. Gilchrist is also seeking a Community Improvement District (CID) designation for the shopping center and environs. (CID passed the City Council on 11/7/08; for more information, go to www.kcmo.org, enter CID Red Bridge in the search box, and click on ordinance #080979).

Julie Gabrielle related her experience with a home burglary and how it spurred her to connect with her neighbors and get involved in the neighborhood.

Barbara presented the proposed budget for the 2008/09 fiscal year as approved by the board. Highlights include increased funding for snow removal and capital improvements funding for refurbishment and maintenance of our 18 islands and plantings and maintenance of the 35 entrance markers. After discussion, those in attendance voted to increase the annual dues to \$50 per year by a vote of 28-16, and the budget (attached) was approved.

Current board members Barbara Robertson, Katherine Coates, Heather O'Malley, Julie Gabrielle and Sharron Hill were re-elected to the board. New volunteers Joe Gawron, Jim Wright, Jim Clossick and Ryan Allenbrand were elected to the board.

The new RBHA board met on November 18th, and chose officers and drew for terms. Starting in January, board meetings will be held on the third Monday of the month, 6-8 P.M., at Dunn's Coffee Shop. All residents are invited to join us and "listen in".
