## Westmont HOA – Restrictions and Enforcement Resolution – What is it?

At the April 2014 meeting your HOA board of directors adopted a Restrictions and Enforcement Resolution (effective May 1, 2014) under the direction and guidance of Rod Hoffman with the law firm Slagle, Bernard & Gorman who specializes in all aspects of Home Associations. Those of you who were in attendance at our 2013 annual meeting may recall his presentation.

So what is this Resolution all about? It is a policy for dealing with violations of Westmont's restrictive covenants. This procedure involves (1) receipt of a written complaint about a violation by a homeowner or board member, (2) investigating the violation by the board, (3) sending notice of the violation and request for compliance to the owner, and (4) conducting a meeting with the owner, if necessary. In simpler terms it is about protecting community harmony as well as individual and collective property values for all Westmont Homeowners.

This procedure is not perfect as there is not a perfect way to handle violations. The hope is that these types of procedures will promote a balanced, cooperative approach to enforcement.

Bottom line we are all neighbors with the aspiration to live in peace and harmony with one another. As your board we ask you to recognize and remember that when you purchased your home you in effect agreed to abide by the Westmont Covenants and Restrictions. These covenants & restrictions went into effect over 30 years ago before the first home was ever built. Please remember any time you plan to make a change, "any change" to the exterior of your home you must first seek the written approval of your HOA Board. In doing so it will save you, and all involved, time and most likely money.
