TREASURER'S REPORT: Delinquent Dues: Seven homeowners are delinquent paying their Westmont Homes Association maintenance fees. It is the responsibility of property owners to keep their monthly maintenance fee payments current. Here are some major points: Fee should be postmarked by the 20th of each month as indicated on the invoice sent by HAKC; Payments received after the 25th of the month will be considered late and penalties will be applied; After three months of payments are in arrears, at the expense of the property owner, a lien will be filed.
