## **HOME WINTERIZATION CHECKLIST**

The ever so unpredictable Ol' Man Winter is almost on us, so make sure you plan ahead. Read the tips on the following page:

- **Be Prepared** Buy a snow shovel now so you'll have it before winter weather hits. Keep extra water and canned food in storage, just in case.
- **Gutters and Downspouts** Clean gutters and downspouts in mid-fall and double-check them before winter. Install leaf guards to keep falling leaves and other debris out of cleared gutters.
- **Heating System** Replace the filter in your furnace. Give your heating system a test run so you know it will work properly when you need it.
- **Insulation** Check the attic, walls and basement for adequate insulation.
- Caulking and Weather Stripping Simple leaks can sap home energy efficiency by 5 to 30 percent a year. Seal small cracks or openings around doors, windows and baseboards with caulk, expanding foam or adhesive weather stripping.
- Run Fans in Reverse Many ceiling units come with a handy switch that reverses the direction of the blades. Counterclockwise rotation produces cooling breezes, while switching to clockwise makes it warmer. Air pooled near the ceiling is circulated back into the living space, may cut your heating costs as much as 10 percent.
- Winterize your A/C and Water Lines Drain any hoses and air conditioner pipes, and make sure you don't have excess water pooled in equipment. If your A/C has a water shutoff valve, go ahead and turn that off. Turn off exterior water spigots. Remove window A/C units and store them so you don't invite cold drafts all winter.
- Sprinkler Systems Have your sprinkler system winterized no later than the end of October.
- Turn Down Your Water Heater Lowering the water temperature to 120 degrees Fahrenheit would reduce your water heating costs by 6 to 10 percent.
- **Mind the Thermostat** For every degree you lower the thermostat during heating season, you'll save between 1 and 3 percent of your heating bill. Make it easier with a programmable thermostat.
- Put on a Sweater A light long-sleeved sweater is worth about 2 degrees in added warmth, while a
  heavy sweater adds about 4 degrees in warmth. So cozy up and start saving.
