Westmont Homes Association Property Values Report: Westmont residents have responded to the most recent Property Inspection Reports. Many have submitting their ARC forms for wood rot repair, painting, fences and more. Some have begun the repairs or have finished.

There are a few homeowners who have the same needed repairs noted on their 2015 Inspection Reports. The Board will do follow-up with them. If no plan is submitted and repairs implemented within an agreed start date, a report will be taken to the City of Overland Park and fines by the city may occur.

If you are planning on outside repairs or painting, get with your roof mate and share your plan thru an ARC form that can be found on or website <a href="www.ha-kc.org">www.ha-kc.org</a>. Get those plans to Shirley Knese who can be located at 913-485-8689 or 12050 Mackey. The Board understands if you are unable to get on your painters list until fall or next spring. Just contact us with your plan.

The majority of residents keep their property in great shape. There are always just a few who do not make any effort. Westmont is a maintenance provided community. That maintenance does not include flower beds, roofs, driveways, or outside of your home. Please walk around your outside. Check your fireplace chimney, roof, siding, driveway and flower beds. If you have bought your house and do not want to keep up flower beds already on your property, have them taken out, or just weed them and put plastic and rock down. That will be pretty maintenance free. Members of the Board will be happy to meet you at your property and offer suggestions should you need assistance.
