TREASURER'S REPORT:

LAWN AND GROUNDS REPORT:

Activities for October and November: 1) Mowing's will continue on Friday's through October, as warranted, and weather permitting, 2) Final lawn application will be applied mid to late November, 3) First leaf cleanup will be scheduled mid November. Pin Oak Alert: Have you noticed that your pin oaks have some yellowing of its leaves and it isn't even autumn yet? Leaf chlorosis (yellowing) is a perennial problem for pin oak trees. If left untreated, trees will defoliate, weaken and may eventually die. Some of the trees in our subdivision are showing signs of chlorosis. It is fixable if caught early enough. The core of your tree may need to be injected with iron to solve the problem. Do you have a tree in need of attention? Unsure? Here are two specialists who have been used by some homeowners in Westmont. Corey at <u>Canyon Creek Iron Core</u>, 913-206-8091 and Matt Dawson at TLC, 913-780-5296. Mention you live in Westmont and TLC will give you a discount. Better to be safe than sorry and let an expert check it out. It costs much less to treat your tree than to pay to replace it because it has died because chlorosis.
