VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT

<u>Property Inspections:</u> Shirley Knese reported, with the exception of a couple of phone calls for guidance, property inspections and improvements are on hold until spring when she will again assist homeowners make plans.

<u>Winter Fence Damage:</u> Shirley has contacted the original installer of our perimeter fence and that company is preparing an estimate for the storm damage to the fence along 119th street.

LAWN AND GROUNDS:

<u>Spring Cleanup</u>: TLC will do spring cleanup mid-March to early April, weather permitting.

<u>Don't Over Seed Your Yard Yet:</u> Following spring cleanup, TLC will apply pre-emergent chemicals mid March to early April, weather permitting. These chemicals are meant to prevent seeds from germinating. All seeds, including grass seed. If you want to over seed or repair lawn areas, wait at least three weeks after pre-emergent chemicals are applied.

TREASURER'S REPORT: The January financial statements and expenses were reviewed and discussed at the January Board meeting. All agreed financials to be in order.
