**Tree Inspections & Treatment** – The Board has negotiated a special opportunity to have your trees inspected and treated should the treatment be necessary. Ryan Lawn & Tree will treat your trees for a cost of \$125 per tree which is \$25 less than their normal rate of \$150. Check your trees and if they are looking more light green than a healthy green, it may be time to treat your trees. Call Ryan Lawn & Tree at 913-381-1505 for a free estimate and no obligation. Make sure to tell them you are a Westmont resident. Of course, it is always your decision to contact a vendor of your choice for work done on your property. But act quickly as there is an optimal "window" for this type of treatment which is June/July. Remember, the cost to remove a diseased tree will be far greater than treatments. ## LAWN AND GROUNDS REPORT – Linda Stogsdill

**Perimeter & Island Landscape Committee Report** – Jan Hodgson and Nancy Kocourek recently completed a walkabout with Mark Huffman of Precision Lawn Care in which they surveyed the perimeter and island landscaping. **June Lawn Activity** – Mowing will continue to be done on Thursdays. Towards the beginning of June, Precision will trim bushes in the common area and apply insecticide as needed. They may also trim bushes in our front yards as needed. Around the middle of the month, fertilizer and grub control will be applied. I will give you advance notice by way of email and info box inserts. Until then, here are some reminders of our responsibilities as it relates to our lawns and trees:

Landscape:

- All flower beds in front, side and back yards should be weeded regularly.
- Evergreens should not block your house number. OVP Police and Fire depts. request this.
- Stone borders around trees and flower beds should be checked regularly to ensure nothing falls into the mowers path.
- Chipmunks love to burrow, so make sure to check for soil erosion around driveways and sidewalks.

Lawn Condition:

- Front and side lawns should be seeded, or sod placed for any bare areas. Watering is needed to maintain the lawns, especially in the summer.
- Rake up acorns from your lawn throughout the season as they are acidic and can damage your lawn.
- Precision is not obligated to mow where there is dog poop, so be sure to keep that picked up.

## Trees:

- The trees on your property are your responsibility. They need thinning and the canopy raised when necessary. Any dead branches should be removed before a strong wind gust makes then dangerous.
- Trees need to be trimmed away from a neighbor's fence. And, if your tree is next to the Westmont Vinyl Fence, its canopy should be at least 8' tall so as not to damage the fence and to give room for the lawn company to mow.
- Additionally, the lawn company is not required to be ducking below low hanging branches to mow in our yards. It is our responsibility to keep them trimmed.
