We did lose our common area trees at the Antioch entrance as well as other fallen limbs, branches and leaves littering the streets, sidewalks and yards making it necessary for residents to clean up the aftermath. Last Call for Tree Inspections & Treatment – Time is running out to make arrangements with Ryan Lawn & Tree to inspect and treat your trees, especially for the iron treatment for our beautiful Pin Oaks. Call them at 913-381-1505 for a free estimate and make sure to tell them you are a Westmont resident to get the discounted price of \$125 for treatment. If you have a tree in front of your house in the boulevard (between the sidewalk and the street), that tree is your responsibility as the city does not take ownership of those trees. At least seven "boulevard" trees need iron treatments. Check to see if one is yours - the tree you save may be your own. Call John Ziegelmeyer or Larry Tittle with questions.

Please check your trees for limbs overhanging the neighbor's fence or the perimeter fence along Antioch and 119th and have them trimmed back.

# TREASURER'S REPORT - Blaine Halvorson

The June financial statements were reviewed with the Board and June revenues and expenses were in order.

This month we had two homeowners who had fallen behind in the monthly dues. The homeowners have been contacted to remind them of their obligation to ensure timely receipt of their payments. We also have two other homeowners who have outstanding penalty and interest charges. These homeowners will be contacted as well.

As a reminder, statements are sent by the HA-KC at the first of the month and are due on receipt. Payments received after the 20th of the month are considered late and subject to a \$15 penalty and interest. This is why I continue to encourage all homeowners to enroll in the HA-KC's automated bank draft service to simplify the monthly dues process. Through this program, payments will be automatically deducted from your bank account each month. Just complete and return an authorization form with your account information to the Homes Association of Kansas City. It's that easy.
