LAWN AND GROUNDS REPORT – Linda Stogsdill

Fall Is Here – Now that we're into fall, the whole flavor of Lawn & Grounds changes. It's good to see folks sprucing up their yards. Many have seeded and the recent rains and cooler weather are making things look much better. Fall is also the perfect time of year to have your trees trimmed of dead branches.

Schedule for October – There will be no special treatments in October other than weekly mowing. This month we will complete the restoration of our median at the Antioch entrance with three new trees to replace the ones that were damaged by the storm.

Only Rain Down The Drain – An article from the Johnson County Magazine reminds us that we need to be careful about what we are putting down the storm drains: 1) Do not rake leaves or acorns into the streets, 2) Clean up after pets. Pet waste left in the grass washes into the storm drains and harmful bacteria in pet waste can contaminate the water. More than 70 miles of creeks, streams, and rivers flow through Overland Park. You can prevent stormwater pollution by following essential sustainability best practices around your home.

Acorns - Try to keep them swept and picked up off your driveway and sidewalks as they will stain it and could become a slipping hazard. Do not sweep them into the street as this is an Overland Park "No No." Collect yard waste in paper yard waste bags and have your trash hauler remove it or take it to a compost facility. And finally, rake them off your lawns as they are very acidic and will smother your grass.
