City Street Snow and Ice Removal

Starting this snow season, the City of Overland Park will test beet juice to treat Westmont streets. Beet juice is an organic based liquid that is less corrosive and less harmful to the environment than more routinely used products. It will not leave any permanent discoloration or stains on concrete or asphalt. It will not harm vehicles, other metal structures, humans or pets. It washes off easily. The city expects beet juice will reduce costs, reduce corrosion and reduce impact on the environment.
