In 2009, Crestwood hired Country Club Tree to trim all the trees on the islands, points and parks as well as remove four trees. In 2010 two more trees were removed. Looking back on an inventory of 1996, Crestwood has lost 10 trees in Cherry Woods alone and most were huge shade trees making up the canopy level. This fall Rosehill had a half price tree sale because of an overstock due to the economy and the Crestwood board decided to take advantage of this. George Eib of Country Club Tree drew up a tree plan which included 7 trees in Cherry Woods and 10 Trees in Happy Woods. This plan was approved by the board and Rosehill should have them planted in mid-November. Eileen has worked diligently to keep the island points and parks beautiful. Her efforts and her success is visible to all. Thanks Eileen.

Special Saturday Trash pickup days

- Veterans Day Nov. 11 trash day Sat. Nov. 13
- Thanksgiving Day Nov 25 Trash day Sat. Nov.27
- Christmas Sat. Dec.25 Trash day is still Friday Dec. 24th, no tag day Fri. Dec. 24 no bag limit. Dec. 31
- New Years Day Sat Jan. 1 do trash day still Fri. Dec. 31
- Martin Luther King Jr. day Jan. 17 trash day Sat. Jan. 22
- President's Day Feb. 21 trash day Sat. Feb 26
- Memorial Day May 30 Trash day Sat June 4th

Recycle (minimize your trash bags for free)

Friday is trash Day.

- For weeks with a holiday like Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas, the pickup day is Saturday.
- Trash on curb by 7 a.m. (no earlier than 3 p.m. the day before.)
- Two bag (30gallon) limit on trash. Additional tags for more bags can be bought at Westlake Ace Hardware of Price Choppers
- Trash in containers or boxes will not be picked up.
- No limit on recycle items but NO Glass or Styrofoam.
- Glass can be taken to the "Ripple" box in Rockhurst parking lot at 5400 Troost or at 51st and Main.
- Bulky items must be scheduled for pickup or you may be fined.

Recycle bins are available at Price Chopper and Westlake Ace hardware for \$9 @ Extra tags for trash bags are \$2.00 @

Leaf and Brush Set-Out dates Friday November 5 and Friday December 10. Remember 20 bag or bundle limit, no trash, no duct tape, paper bags only, must be set out by 7 a.m. on Friday. Call 3-1-1 within 24 hours to report any misses.
