- E. We will be trimming the trees hanging over the sidewalks on 119th street. The homeowners have been notified and they are acceptable.
- F. We had some storm damage to the perimeter and pear trees on the islands. NTN have picked these up.
- G. The boring contractor (Bear communications) installing the buried TWC cable filled and repaired the damage done to the existing grass and they seeded the areas and putting straw down. The grass has germinated and growing very well. We will see what the summer brings. They were told if it does not grow, they will have to reseed in the fall. They agreed. This same contractor damaged the bush on the west side of 119th entrance. We will see how the bush comes out before following up further with BEAR. They were notified.
- H. There are a lot of dead bushes on the 117th entrance Islands. The committee will be proposing a landscaping motion during new business.




A. Landscaping:




