He is working with Tim Whitehead of the City Traffic Control department, and has police sitting at that corner and ticketing speeders and trucks. He further suggested that we work with the other associations from the Plaza to Brookside to get the homeowners on Brookside Boulevard to do a sign campaign. The signs would show the symbol for No Trucks, Boulevard, and the Dollar Fine for driving a truck there. His thought was a full 15 blocks of signs would get the attention of the media (print and maybe TV) to highlight the effort. We do not want Brookside to turn into another Shawnee Mission Parkway.

He also mentioned he had attended a neighborhood meeting last summer, one of the topics being sidewalk and curb replacement. He has 60 - 7- homeowner signatures from the blocks around him as a start towards applying for PIAC money. He is willing to spearhead that effort if we want to do that for the whole HOA.

Mario, do you know the PIAC rules for something like this? Can we apply for a total grant to do sidewalks and curbs, or is the homeowner liable for some, or all, of the costs?
