Pat Jerez attended the meeting and said she had volunteered to take care of the triangle by our new park. She is willing to plant for spring and we are willing to pay for that within reason. We intend to redo the stone marker but will not get to it until late this year anyway.

We need to look into what it will take to get power to the island if we are going to model the marker after the one on 52nd and Wyandotte.

Gary talked with John Sheets who knows a person who can do the mud jacking to get the marker level if we wish. We will wait to see what we need to do to match the 52st marker.

Gary said the 5th and Wyandotte marker now also has an urn.

Pat asked about the work necessary to do a historic designation on the houses east of Main. We said that had been looked into and was cost prohibitive.

Darryl mentioned we will be celebrating the 100th year of Countryside in 2008 and should plan a party. Darryl is building a historic archive for the occasion. We will keep that on our agenda as we go forward.

We need to ask Tracy about the dumpster date. It apparently needs to move.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 PM.
