**Financial:** Larry Engel-This 3<sup>rd</sup> snow removal will put us over budget but Larry feels in the end the budget will balance fairly close. Garage sale will be 2<sup>nd</sup> weekend in Sept, beginning 9/13/13 and Fall Festival will be 2<sup>nd</sup> weekend in Oct, 10/12/13. Discussed annual meeting locations, Avila vs. Blue Hills along with whether or not liquor should be offered, discussed food. Doris will have costs ready for next meeting.

**Common Areas: Ed McHardie**- Good News! We will not be getting a bill from the city for the additional mowing last summer, saving \$2000!

Almost all of the dead trees along State Line have been replaced accept for 3-4 which will be done as soon as weather clears. The lake has been cleaned and the city had a great response time. We will take action on the dead tree at approx. 120<sup>th</sup> and Summit in the common area. Good news on the PIAC request—had we submitted earlier the shelter for the park would have been approved. By the end of the year they may have enough money to pay for the shelter house. Then a discussion ensued on whether or not we really want a shelter house in the area. Joe is going to invite Steve Lampone to our next meeting to discuss the negatives. Also discussed other ways to enhance the park with walking trails, exercise equipment, additional seating, swings.
