The recent description of it shows plat restrictions stating the site is doubly zoned as Single Family Residential within 100 feet of Wornall Road and still zoned for school use. The District does not intend to remove these covenants at this time. The site and Building have been appraised for 1.15 million. Bids are being accepted until October 12.
