#### Since the last Board Meeting:

Annual Picnic review and highlights

- Reviewed expenses Total expenses were \$2,017, less cash collected \$552, net \$1,465
- o 67 Adults and 12 children attended this year's event, prior year's attendance was 61 and 7 respectively
- o A tentative date of September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2026, was set for the next Annual Picnic
- FINAL First Friday at the Fountain Thanks to Margaret for hosting.
  - Well attended, just under 30 neighbors attended, lots of new people, lots of kids
  - o The Board agreed to continue First Fridays at the Fountain in 2026 for months April through October
- Petitions in support of PIAC request to repair curbs and walks at Westwood Road bridge over Brush Creek were submitted and confirmation the petition was received
- Update on the board reviewing options for long-term construction site in neighborhood
  - o A complaint was filed with the City and the resident notified/cited
