# **NEWS and reminders from the BOARD:**

• Visibility & Safety –Walking on unlit streets with no sidewalks can be very hazardous for all.

Walkers - please use flashlights and / or wear high visibility clothing so drivers can see you.

Drivers – Please slow down and give walkers a wide berth.

- **Dogs roaming in the Neighborhood** There have been reports of aggressive dogs roaming the neighborhood. While there are no leash laws this does not mean that they can run free. Dogs must be under control at all time, even while off-leash and residents are responsible for the actions their dogs may do while off-leash. Please also pick up your poop bags and do not leave them on the side of the street.
- Yard maintenance Please keep your grounds well maintained and free of excessive trash and brush. Brush piles should be burned or removed annually. The Johnson County Fire District #2 station #81 at 19120 Metcalf covers our neighborhood and will issue 30 day burn permits.

When burning, please do not burn wet leaves or brush that cause excessive smoke.

• Roofs / garages / home additions / fences – These all need approval from the architectural committee. When planning any of these improvements, please bring it to our attention early, and we will help residents through this process.
