

You may also bring tires. These items must normally be taken to the city recycling facilities on Deramus Street or Raytown Road.

The event will be held at Hale Cook School which is located in the Waldo area. Hale Cook takes up an entire city block between 73rd and 74th Streets, Pennsylvania to Jefferson. The trucks will be parked on the south side of the building. All traffic will enter on Pennsylvania and exit on Jefferson.

It has been asked that all those who come to the event to bring a can of food to donate to Harvesters.
