In working with Mark these past two years, the board has become aware that there will come a time when some plantings need to be removed and/or replaced. Trees become damaged by disease beyond repair treatments and plantings outlive their natural lifespan. In anticipation, we are launching an effort to work with Mark on a replacement policy that favors native plants. Their natural beauty will not only bring greater sustainability to our landscaping but would require less water, trimming, and pest control which could also result in savings for the community. Three board members, Jan, Nancy, and Larry have volunteered to work with Mark to develop a plan and we would welcome other interested volunteers, particularly if we have any master gardeners among us who would like to share their expertise.
