First, spring rains can be very heavy and can cause expensive water damage for you and neighbors. Please make sure your gutters are draining onto your own property- any side gutters must drain to front of YOUR house or to back of YOUR house, not onto the neighbor's property

this is a city code violation.

Second, fences: good communication with your neighbors is cricial.

Don't expect a fence company to know where your property lines are, so always start with a pegged property survey.





#### Parks & Islands - Jane Aylward

Parks and Islands is slow this time of year, so here is info about the space between the sidewalk and curb, commonly called "the parking".

The city has a right-of-way between the sidewalk and curb on your property, but the property belongs to you, not KCMO. On parks and islands, everything from the roots up belongs to Armour Fields, including statues, urns, fountains, all plantings. If someone walking his dog tells you he and his dog have a right to do whatever on your property or the parks and islands because it is a "right-of-way", tell him <u>only</u> KCMO has very specific r-o-w privileges, not individuals.

The trees on the parking, however, do belong to the city. If the one on your lot has issues, either call 311 or go to kcmo.org, click on the 311 Center highlight, then click on the Report a problem online highlight, and map of the city will open. Left click on the magnifier tool (looks like a magnifying glass) and use it to scan down to our neighborhood, find your lot and click on it. Fill in and submit the form, and include a photo attachment showing the problem, if possible. 311 will acknowledge your submission and email you when the city action has been completed. They trim, limb up and remove trees at their discretion.

You can also use the 311 form to notify KCMO of other issues, even if they are not on your property. If:

- the gumballs are piling up--they will send the street cleaner
- the storm drains are clogged--they will send a cleanout crew
- depressions are developing in the street or along the parking--this often indicates a water main or sewer leak. They will investigate and put the spot on their repair list, maybe even make it a priority
- a street sign is down--they replace these really fast
- -water is bubbling up in the street--there will often be someone there by the time you are on the way back from running errands.
- -a neighbor is draining his pool across your yard or into the street--even on a weekend, they will send someone out to ticket the homeowner

-if someone puts an advertisement for a business or service on a utility pole--they will remove it


#### Other good-to-know city info:

- -If a limb falls blocking the street--call 911 day or night, they will send a crew asap because it could block a fire truck/EMT crew.
- -If someone puts an advertisement, event notice, real estate, political or service company "nuisance sign" on your parking or in your yard, pull it then call me at 816/520-0750 and I will drop off a designated KCMO bag so you can put it out with your trash on Thursday. Nuisance signs are never allowed on parks, parkways, islands, entry walls, the Trolley Trail or within 10' of the curb of any street, KCMO city ordinance 120312, section 48-47. If they want to put them on the house side of your sidewalk, they have to ask you first.

We planted lots of daffodils and tulips last fall and are planning to plant pansies in the urns as soon as they become available. We have ordered white dogwood trees for the beds in Ward Parkway Park, they should arrive in March or April. Armour Fields is beautiful in the spring, we try to make it more so every year.

#### 2016: A Year to Stabilize AFHA Finances - Stu Bintner, Treasurer

The final financial figures for calendar 2015 are in, and the Armour Fields Homes Association is in stable financial condition. While there have been some deferred repairs to masonry and other areas, the financial status remains satisfactory—especially if the amount of snow removal remains low. This is particularly good news considering that most residence paid lower dues this year than last. This year the combined total for the base and (then) optional dues were combined and lowered from \$165 to \$155.

On another positive note, about ninety percent of the members have completed their dues payments though the end of the fiscal year, which ends on March 31. (Remember that fiscal year 2017 will begin for AFHA on April1). A note of gratitude is extended to those who are current on their obligation. These funds are vital in maintaining the special nature of our area and its unique place in Kansas City. It is a great place to live, and you help make it so!

Those who have not paid the remainder of the current years dues are reminded to do so before the **end of March**.

If the dues remain unpaid voting priviledges at the annual meeting will be revoked.
