President's Message

I regret to have to report that there have been a number of criminal activities in Wornall Homestead and the surrounding areas in recent weeks. There was, for example, an attempted, but thankfully unsuccessful, armed robbery of one of our residents in the middle of the day on Central near 58th Street. Officer John Trainor of the KCMO Police Dept. supplied me with a list of criminal activity that has occurred so far this year in our area. To cite just a few more examples, there have been 17 actual or attempted burglaries, 35 cases of theft (auto parts, bikes, etc.) and 5 instances of non-aggravated assault. While Office Trainor says the numbers are not unusual, it is still advisable for us all to be cautious and observant.

If you are interested in finding out the best ways of preventing crime in our neighborhood, there will be a Neighborhood Watch Training meeting on November 13, 6:30 - 8:30 p.m. at Rockhurst University Community Center, 5401 Troost. For more information and to pre-register (recommended but not required), call 816-513-3200. If we have enough residents attending that program, we will qualify for free Neighborhood Watch Road Signs.

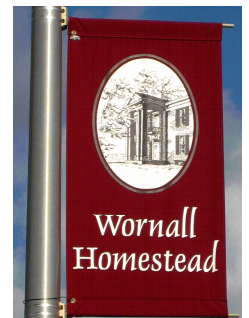

Neighborhood Inspection Report: Looking Good

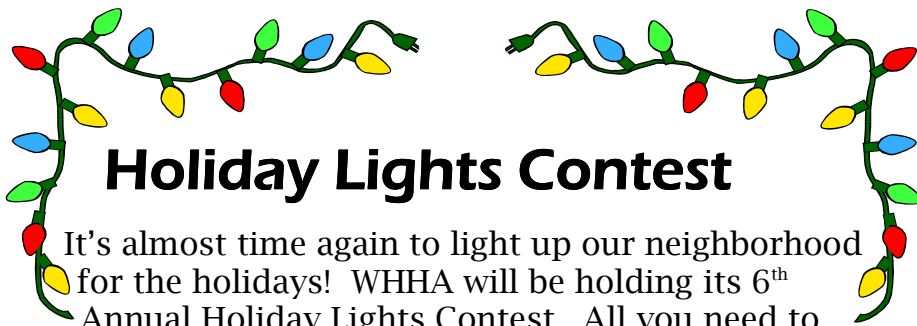
