### Trees for Wornall Homestead

Kansas City Parks and Recreation and the Heartland Tree Alliance have launched a new street tree replacement program that assists homeowners in planting trees. Our neighborhood will be one of the first in the city in this effort! Supported by trained volunteers from the Heartland Tree Alliance – a program of Kansas City-based Bridging the Gap -- residents of Wornall Homestead will plant our own trees, and learn how to care for them in the coming years, to assure they become healthy and long term assets to our urban forest.



Residents will be contacted about this program based on our own tree survey which was submitted to the city in 2010 and on request for street trees. If you are interested in obtaining a free tree for planting in the public right-of-way in front of your home or are interested in helping to planting trees with your neighbors or want to help volunteer in another way, please contact Eric at eyoungberg@nw.org. This effort will culminate in planting 100 street trees throughout the neighborhood in one day in April or early May. We'll also have a party to celebrate our efforts. 

# Let It Snow...

At the Wornall Homestead Homes Association annual meeting, November 2011, a proposal was overwhelmingly supported by all homeowners in attendance. On the annual dues billing you will find an additional line "special assessment" for \$15.00. This reflects the amount approved for the year. Private snow removal will be triggered by a snowfall of 2 inches or more. The streets will be plowed curb to curb (unlike city plowing which is typically one pass down the middle). # Wornall Homestead History

#### **Wornall Homestead Architects**

The Tillie D. Sullivan residence is located at the northwest corner of 61st and Wyandotte Streets. It is a classic Mediterranean style house built for a whopping \$15,000 in 1922. It was designed by Edgar C. Faris (1882-1945). Faris was city architect for Kansas City, Missouri and worked extensively with Tom Pendergast, designing Pendergast's first residence in the Country Club District. Faris designed the city market, numerous fire stations and was especially adept at the Mediterranean style including the William Collins residence at 232 West 52nd Street, the Alcazar apartments at 3906 Baltimore and the Ponce de Leon apartments at 4555 Main Street. He later became nationally known as a landscape and portrait painter. He attended the



Kansas City Art Institute. Faris moved to Miami for a couple years in the 1920's, back to Kansas City and later moved to Los Angeles in 1944, where he died one year later. The Sullivan residence is the only building designed by Faris in Wornall Homestead. The long time current owner has the original architectural plans for the house. -Eric Youngberg


