Board News

No Soliciting Signs: The Board unanimously voted to place No Soliciting signs at all Westmont entrances. A bid from Westport Sign Company was accepted for a cost of \$160.00. At the Open Board Meeting in February, a resident requested the board look into these signs.

<u>Snow Removal:</u> We've had three major snow storms this winter. The Board is carefully monitoring budgeted monies for snow removal in Westmont. For the last snow fall March 23-24, Summit came after Overland Park plowed the streets, allowing for clear pathways from your driveway to the street.

<u>Damaged Perimeter Fence On 119th Street:</u> There was fence damage to some of the perimeter fence by city snow removal trucks, as the force of the snow blown off the streets hit the fence. The City of Overland Park has asked the Board to get estimates for repairs. The City will reimburse Westmont for the costs.

<u>Property Value Inspections:</u> Last spring the Property Value Committee completed property inspections. Property Value's Chairman Mike Perry reported his committee plans to do follow-up inspections for some homes this coming April through May. Since the initial inspections last year, residents have made many improvements including: New garage doors, driveways and roofs; repaired chimneys, sidewalks, and fences; exterior repairs and painting; and new landscaping.
