# What's Up Westmont? September 2015 Newsletter

With all the news on home invasions, we thought it worthwhile to share a safety tip and garage door security tips:

1) This tip was shared by our good neighbor, Harold Raasch. Take your car key fob with you to bed each night and place it on your nightstand in easy reach. If you hear some unusual noises or glass breaking, press the panic button. This will set off your car alarm. The last thing a burglar wants to hear is a lot of noise, so this will certainly send them running.

2) Don't leave your garage door open. It doesn't matter how safe you think the neighborhood is, good neighborhoods are the first place criminals like to drive through to case houses. It's amazing how many people leave their garage door open all the time. It's just inviting someone to pop their heads in and grab something

3) If you park a vehicle outside, don't leave the garage door remote in your vehicle. If a thief breaks in to your car and steals the remote, he now has a way into your home. Consider a keychain remote opener.

4) Secure your garage door emergency release. The safety release mechanism can be tripped from outside your garage door with nothing more than a coat hanger. Use two or three "bread bag ties" (inserted and tied individually) to lock the disengaging arm on the automatic opener. While this will prevent the bypass technique employed by thieves, the safety pull handle can still be yanked hard to break the thin wire ties in an emergency.

5) Make sure the entry door from the garage is a strong, sturdy door made out of solid-core wood or reinforced steel like your front door. Install a dead-bolt lock and Anti-Kick device like the "Door Devil" on it!

6) Install a wide-angle peephole in the door between your house and your garage. You'll at least be able to see what's going on if you hear a strange noise rather than opening the door to find out. If someone is out there, press the panic button on your car key fob then call 911.

7) Frost or cover your garage windows. Don't do thieves any favors by enabling them to see when your vehicle is gone. A better idea would be to replace the door with one that lacks windows.

8) When you plan to leave town, padlock the throw latch on your garage door. If you don't have a manual lock on your garage door, you can use a vice grip on each side of the door track to effectively "lock" down the door.

**Inspections:** We are seeing a lot of activity in the neighborhood with residents taking care of items identified during the inspection. Thank you for making Westmont a beautiful place to live.
