Recycling - Trees & Lights: Johnson County Parks and Recreation will be accepting post-holiday natural Christmas trees at three locations from Dec 26th thru Jan 31st. Collection sites are: 1) parking lot of Theatre in the Park in Shawnee Mission Park (7710 Renner Road, Shawnee), 2) Heritage Park Marina parking lot (16050 Pflumm Road, Olathe), and 3) north side parking lot at the marina at Kill Creek Park (11670 Homestead Lane, Olathe). Trees will be collected during regular winter park hours which are 7:30am to 8pm. There is no charge. For additional information, call 913-888-4713. TREASURER'S REPORT

You can start off the New Year with automatic bank withdrawal for HOA dues payment. Consider this easy way to pay your monthly Westmont Association dues. Contact the HA-KC management consultant at 913-385-2440 to make arrangements for automatic monthly withdrawal from your bank. It's that easy!

2017 Budget: The budget was approved by the board at the Dec 19th monthly meeting. The budget for next year exceeds the revenue. This is primarily due to the planned tree trimming. It was the decision of the board that the excess expense would be covered by the reserves which have increased due to the last 2 years of minimal snows. The only other budget line item increase from last year is for Trash and Recycle Services. The board closely monitors our monthly and annual expenses so that the Westmont financial condition remains sound. A year end accounting for 2016 will be reported in the February newsletter. Thank you again for keeping your association dues payments current. This is how we can all do our part in keeping Westmont an attractive community to live.

GROUNDS COMMITTEE

Tree Trimming: Every five years, the board solicits bids for trees to be trimmed in Westmont. The board has identified one tree per property to be trimmed and paid for by the Westmont HOA and these trees have been marked with a pink ribbon. We are also offering homeowners to get additional trees trimmed, at their expense, but at the same negotiated rate. To date, 50 trees have been marked with a green ribbon by homeowners requesting trimming or cut down. Trimming will take place in Feb 2017. Leaf Cleanup: Spectrum has completed the first of two leaf cleanings, and had started on the second. Unfortunately, the snow interrupted their work. They will finish the leaf cleaning as soon as weather permits.

Snow Removal: Snow removal will occur when snow is above two inches. Your driveway, front sidewalk, and neighborhood sidewalks will be cleared. Spectrum will begin clearing snow when, according to weather reports, the snow storm is predicted to end. When our snow crew is here to clean your driveway, please have your vehicles in the garage or along the curb. If you have vehicles in your driveway, it can't be cleared of snow. When city snow plows are in our neighborhood, try to have your vehicles off the street. OP states: "Crews do their best to clear residential streets as quickly as possible. Their job is made easier when there are few vehicles parked on a street..." Vehicles "slow the operation and delay getting the streets cleaned." A web-based snow map to monitor plowing progress is available at opkansas.org.

Driveway Markers: With the coming of winter, residents are encouraged to purchase/install reflective markers. The markers alert the snow removal crews of the locations of the driveway dividers and significantly reduces the risk of damage to plantings.
