March Financials: March financial statements and expenses were reviewed and discussed at the February Board meeting. All agreed financials to be in order.

LAWN AND GROUNDS

Mowing on Fridays: Due to unfriendly weather, the grass is taking off a bit more slowly than usual. As warmer weather arrives, expect TLC to be mowing our lawns on Fridays, weather permitting of course. It's recommended you do not to water your yard on Thursdays and wait until your yard is mowed on Friday to resume your watering schedule. Be sure fenced in areas are accessible to the mowing crews. In addition, please be courteous and pick up sticks and branches in your yard so the mowers won't be interrupted while mowing. Remember, we as homeowners also have responsibility for our lawns, i.e., weed pulling, seeding, etc., which is not covered by our TLC contract. If you need work done, feel free to contact TLC or another service provider of your choice for assistance.

Lawn Care: At the end of March, the first application of fertilizer, broad leaf and pre-emergent herbicide was applied by TLC. A second application will be done <u>April 30th</u>, weather permitting. This will address the dandelions that have popped up in our neighborhood. Watch our Message Boxes near the mail boxes for updates. If you do not want your

yard treated, be sure to place a sign in your yard. The next application will be a small tree/shrub spray that will treat for insects and bag worms and will be applied mid-May. Watch our Message Boxes for more information. TLC will spray the front and side small trees and shrubs that are visible from the street.

The purpose of registration is to ensure they don't miss anyone. Ozanam is well known and highly respected in the KC area as a residential and outpatient treatment center of care for children with social/emotional diagnoses.

Ozanam needs clothing for men, women and children, working appliances, furniture, small kitchen and bath appliances, bath and bedding items, housewares, electronics, jewelry, lamps, shoes, and toys. Please put smaller items in boxes or bags and mark with the letters "**OZ**". They will not pick up tires; dirty mattresses, sleeper sofas; tube TVs & monitors; furniture in need of repair; no construction materials; no gas fired grills, mowers or trimmers; no broken things. Ozanam has the authority to refuse to accept and pick up items.
