#### **VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT**

Vice President Shirley Knese presented ARC forms submitted by homeowners. Following review of each, requests for additional information for some were made.

If you are submitting an ARC form, relevant Information may include city permits; materials, property boundaries in relation to structure or patio, etc; name of professional contractor or installer; drawings or photos; and other information the homeowner wishes to include. Please do not begin your project until the ARC form has been signed by board members and return to you.

Keep an eye out for improvements homeowners are making. They are quite attractive!

<u>Perimeter Fence Repair:</u> Fence damage due to snow storms will be completed soon.

**TREASURER'S REPORT:** Treasurer Bev Kitts reviewed the March financial statements and expenses with the board and a discussion followed. All agreed financials to be in order.

**LAWN AND GROUNDS REPORT:** Mowing day will be on Friday.

Balanced Fertilizer Application, Second Round of Broad-Leaf Pre-emergent, and Grub

<u>Control:</u> Weather permitting, these applications will be the first-second week of June. If you don't want this service, put a sign in your front yard. Before pets are allowed in the yard, wait 20 minutes or until spray is dry on the grass blades. <u>Your grass must be watered by the next day to activate the pre-emergent.</u>

<u>Summer Shrub Trimming June 17:</u> Grounds Chair John Rudzinski reported TLC will begin shrub trimming June 17<sup>th</sup> and may extend into the following week. If you don't want you shrubs trimmed, put a sign in your front yard "No Trimming." Trimming shrubs in the front of the yard is included with your dues. <u>Tie a red ribbon on a branch of each shrub you do NOT want TLC to trim.</u> Call TLC at 913-780-5296 for additional trimming services.

<u>Mowing in Westmont:</u> Heavy and continuous rain in May has had a huge impact on mowing: delayed mowing resulting in fast growing grass, lumps of mowed grass on the yards: areas of yards saturated with pooled water; mowed grass sticking to driveways and walks. Though some neighbors expressed concerns about these things, raking mowed grass and sweeping wet grass off drives and sidewalks falls to the homeowner. We do not have a contract agreement with TLC to perform such services.

We now have a team of seven homeowners who represent designated areas of Westmont. The volunteer in your area will walk around yards on mowing days to determine if contractual agreements with TLC are being met. For example, mowing front and back yards; trimming; blowing grass from hard surfaces; and closing gates.

By the way, please be sure your fence gates are unlocked on mowing day.

<u>WESTMONT NEIGHBORHOOD GARAGE SALE:</u> Despite the rain, there were 17 neighbors who participated. There was a steady stream of customer flow, especially Thursday afternoon and Friday.
