LAWN AND GROUNDS REPORT – John Rudzinski

Precision Lawn Activities for April – Precision Lawn had planned to start mowing on Thursday, April 4th, however, due to the early spring, we may have the first mow on March 28th, weather permitting. Round two fertilizer and crabgrass/broadleaf weed control will also be applied in April. A directory spot email notification will be sent out a few days prior to the activity taking place.

As a reminder, your Westmont HOA dues pay for basic lawn care as opposed to custom. It does not include seeding or sodding or your lawn. If you do not want your lawn mowed/trimmed or chemicals applied, please indicate with a yard sign. Put the sign out a day or two before the activity and take it down afterwards. Please do not leave the sign up as a permanent fixture on your lawn.

Other Lawn Reminders – 1) Check your lawn to see if any straw mats or plastic netting is visible and remove them as they are dangerous for the mowers. These may have come with new sod or seeding by the Gas Company a year or two ago; 2) Check the trees in your yard to ensure there is an 8-foot canopy as the mowers need to drive under the trees to mow. Also, make sure your trees are clear of your neighbor's fence and the perimeter fence; 3) If you would like your back yard mowed and you have a fence be sure to unlock the gate and make sure you have picked up after your dog; 4) Per the City of OP, maintenance of the street trees and lawn in the right of way or boulevard is the responsibility of the adjacent property owner.
