PRESIDENT'S REPORT – John Ziegelmeyer

Westmont Happy Hour – Thanks to everyone who joined us for the happy hour on April 24. It was wonderful to see so many neighbors come together and enjoy each other's company. The weather was perfect and we had about 45 people there. Sprinkler Activation – After our spring rains when we head into summer, we will need to water our lawns to keep them looking good. Sprinkler activation is the responsibility of the homeowner. There are several companies that provide this service so talk to your neighbors and find out who they use. The cost might be anywhere from \$50 to \$100 depending on how many zones you have.

Driveways – We are aware of many driveways in need of replacement or repair and I am in the process of contacting and/or following up with homeowners for some recommendations. Many of the driveways could just use a good power washing to approve the overall appearance.

TREASURER'S REPORT – Blaine Halvorson

The March financial reporting has been reviewed and our March revenues and expenses were in order.

This month we have three delinquencies. One homeowner is one month in arrears. I am optimistic this will be corrected before the month end. We have one homeowner who is two months in arrears, and includes late fees and penalties. I have prepared and sent a letter reminding the homeowner to bring their account to currency, including their late fees and interest. And finally, we have one homeowner who is three or more months in arrears. I have referred this homeowner to the HA-KC for communication and processing.

These incidents are unfortunate and can be avoided. Please consider enrolling in the HA-KC's automated bank service to simplify your monthly dues process. Through this program, monthly payments are automatically deducted from your bank account each month. The program is free and there are no monthly service charges or fees.

LAWN AND GROUNDS REPORT – John Rudzinski

Precision Lawn Activities for May – Not too much going on except our regular weekly mowing on Thursdays, weather permitting. The alternate day for mowing will be Fridays. Here are a few reminders: 1) Set your sprinklers to not water on Thursdays or Fridays, 2) Remember to unlock your backyard gate if you want that part of your yard mowed, 3) Pick up the branches and sticks on your lawn and cut and bundle them for the Waste Management pickup on Friday, and 4) Pick up after your dog in your backyards.

Precision Lawn is scheduled to do two chemical applications the latter part of April that could move to May due to weather. One is a broadleaf weed spray that will hopefully get rid of all of the "chickweed" and the other is a preemergent and fertilizer. LANDSCAPE COMMITTEE – Sharon Kralicek

Get Ready For Some Color – Sharon and the landscape committee have been working on plans to spruce up the Westmont perimeter and entrances with native grasses and flowers. We have contracted Lawn & Landscape Solutions to: 1) add ornamental grass and coneflowers to the 119th Street island and entrance, 2) replace a spruce tree and add ornamental grass and coneflowers to the Antioch & 119th Street corner, and 3) replace a hydrangea and liriope at the Antioch entrance. Planting will take place on April 29, weather permitting.

Thank you to Sharon and the landscape committee for their hard work on the planning and to Larry Tittle and Sheldon Bicknell who removed the dying shrubs and trees along the perimeters and corner saving Westmont some money and giving it a nice clean look. We will reassess the space in the fall to see if we will plant something in these areas.
