## September 22-29: Westmont Homeowners Lawn Upgrade

The following message may seem like lots of details. Our hope in this newsletter is to give you all the information you may need so that this project is successful for you. The grounds committee and the Board put this project into the 2014 budget because all homeowners would benefit. Ken Knese and Spectrum Lawn Service have given much time and done much planning so that this project is successful for all residents in our community.

Every homeowner's front and back yard will be aerated and over-seeded with a tall fescue blend with a rye mix certified seed from Tristar. Bare ground will be verticut before seed is spread. This seed is not guaranteed to grow. It will take your tender care and consistent watering to flourish. If you do not want this service, call Ken Knese at 481-1123.

With a flag marker or other visible marker, mark irrigation sprinkler heads and valve boxes, french drain outlets, electric dog fences, and anything else that may be in your ground so that the aeration/verticut machines will not hit these things. (Spectrum will mark these things for you for an additional charge.)

Westmont Homes Association and Spectrum Lawn Service will not be responsible for damage to the items that are not properly marked. Westmont Homes Association and Spectrum Lawn Service will not be responsible for damage to TV, internet, and phone cable; other types of cable; and any other city utilities that are not buried properly.

Weeks before this Lawn Upgrade begins, Spectrum crews will apply a pre-spray treatment for nut-grass, crab grass, and other noxious, invasive vegetation.

Spectrum will mow the week of Sept. 15<sup>th</sup>. They will not mow the week of Sept 22<sup>nd</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> so that germinating seeds are not disturbed.

**Watering Your Lawn:** You should water your entire lawn, whether by hand, sprinklers, or an irrigation system. It's advised you water every section of your lawn for approximately 30 minutes everyday for 2-3 weeks, depending on the rain we get. Once germination has started and growth has reached 2-3 inches, you may decrease watering. If the temperature is 90 degrees or higher, continue with 30 minutes per day until the weather cools.

<u>Your Flower Beds and Spaces Between Driveways:</u> Neither of these areas is treated for weeds by Spectrum Lawn Care. Residents must individually tend to them: Weed them and perhaps apply commercial spray or granules to prevent weeds; remove debris and trash; and maintain general appearance. Westmont Association contracts with Spectrum for mowing grass, yard maintenance, and snow removal.
