To Corinth Hills Members,

It appears 2021 is a close repeat to 2020 in that many events and norms must change, again. Like last year, you have the annual All Members Meeting in your hand! In lieu of an in-person meeting the Board recommended the Open Meeting format. I will call this meeting to order ... and we will keep it open through 12-31-2021. During this time, you will find the Financial Statements posted on the Web site (location listed above in the Banner) and have the opportunity to cast write-in votes for Board of Directors and Officers. I will list the suggested slate below. Feel free to contact me with comments, questions or concerns.

**Old Business** – Financial Condition, with limited activities we stayed well under budget for a second year. At the time of this writing the 09-30-21 Financials were posted. Revenues based on our \$50 per year HOA Dues, interest and fee income results in \$22,980 in Revenues (there were 7 delinquent accounts as of 09-30-21 out of 452 residences) and a total of \$13,493 in expenses vs a budgeted Total Expenses of \$18,728 resulting in Net Income as of 09-30-21 at \$9,488. Note: this budget is based on normal activities and expenses and represents a balanced budget in a normal year. Total Balance Sheet reserves of \$34,829. The reserves are appropriate for a non-profit as compared to the total annual expenses. The 10-31-2021 fiscal year-end financials will be posted on the website through 12-31-21.

Islands: All the islands reflected the master gardener touch of our volunteers, a source of pride for everyone to enjoy. The Roe entrances at 83<sup>rd</sup> and 79<sup>th</sup> Streets are contracted out to Joan and Andy O'Hare who continue to grab our attention with robust and evolving colors. Please take a moment and thank those tending the islands when you see them working, we are very fortunate to have them.

The annual picnic at your house 2.0 was held August 6<sup>th</sup> and I witnessed many group efforts this year. Two ice cream trucks made the rounds from 6 pm to 8 pm nearly doubling the ice cream treats given out over last year. We have had comments to continue this format and comments to return to Harmon Park. Each has merits to consider. It is still hard to predict how we will all get to interact by August 2022. Stay tuned and check the website calendar for information.

Home sales have been brisk again this year in Corinth Hills. At last reporting we had 21 new homeowners in 2021. This is nearly the same as in 2020 and represents the demand to live in a great community.

Historic Trails: The project to mark and sign the three Historic Trails (Santa Fe, Oregon, and California Trails) in Corinth Hills and other Prairie Village neighborhoods is now complete. Look for signs to go up in November along the 3-mile trail route in P.V. and in Corinth Hills. The signage includes a link to the city website for more in-depth information on the Historic Trails in our area. It features some of the beautiful and creative front yard gardens that our residents have in our neighborhood for all to enjoy.
