HOMES ASSOCIATION DECLARATION

THIS DECLARATION, Made and entered into on this 6th day of May, 1959, by J. C. NICHOLS COMPANY, a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Missouri, and authorized to do business in the State of Kansas, having its principal place of business in Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri,

WITNESSETH: That,

WHEREAS, By the terms and provisions of a certain Declaration dated July 12, 1955, and recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds of Johnson County, Kansas, in Book 72 of Miscellaneous at Page 483, provision was made for the creation and establishment of the Corinth Hills Homes Association, having within its jurisdiction that land shown on the plat of Corinth Hills which is recorded in the office of the aforesaid Register of Deeds in Plat Book 18, at Page 50; and

WHEREAS, Provision was made in said Declaration for the addition to the District, as the term "District" is defined in said Declaration, of such land as was then or might thereafter be owned or approved for addition by J. C. Nichols Company; and

WHEREAS, said J. C. Nichols Company is the owner of Lots 19 to 42, both inclusive, in Block 7, Lots 8 to 21, both inclusive, in Block 8, Lots 20 to 31, both inclusive, in Block 9, Lots 8 to 26, both inclusive, in Block 10, and Lots 3 to 12, both inclusive, in Block 11, of Corinth Hills, a subdivision of land in the City of Prairie Village, in Johnson County, Kansas, as shown on the recorded plats thereof; and

WHEREAS, said J. C. Nichols Company now desires to subject all of said lots to the benefits to be derived from the operation of the aforesaid Association, and to the liability for the payment of the assessments which said Association is authorized to levy against the land within its jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, and in consideration of the benefits to be derived from the operation of said Association, and by virtue of the right to add other land to the District within the jurisdiction of said Association, as aforesaid, J. C. Nichols Company does hereby declare that Lots 19 to 42, both inclusive, in Block 7, Lots 8 to 21, both inclusive, in Block 8, Lots 20 to 31, both inclusive, in Block 9, Lots 8 to 26, both inclusive, in Block 10, and Lots

3 to 12, both inclusive, in Block 11, of Corinth Hills, a subdivision of land in the City of Prairie Village, in Johnson County, Kansas, as aforesaid, shall be and the same are hereby made subject to all of the terms and provisions and benefits and burdens of the aforesaid Declaration dated July 12, 1955, and recorded in the office of the aforesaid Register of Deeds in Book 72 of Miscellaneous at Page 483, in the same way and manner as though all of the said lots had been described in said original Declaration and subjected to the terms and provisions thereof.
